Head Coach and/or High Performance Coach

Part-time positions, which may be approximately 10 hours a week (to be discussed) and if combined, the number of hours would be 20 to 30 hours a week.

Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement comprehensive training plans for athletes of all levels.
- Plan training schedules and annual club calendar
- See to the selection of the teams and of extra routines (solo, duet) and organization of private lessons, in collaboration with the coaches.
- Coach, evaluate and assist coaches by ensuring a healthy and harmonious work environment.
- Identify the short and long term training needs of the coaches.
- Ensure ongoing communication with swimmers, coaches, parents, board members, City of Gatineau, etc.
- Coordinate club registration for swimmers, registration for competitions, meetings and training schedule. .
- Propose an action plan to the Board, early in the season, and work closely with them throughout the season.
- Supervise club events (shows, competitions and other activities)
- Coach the High performance program
- Plan fitness camps
