ocrateries	Once the competition has begun, scratches must be made on deck at the scoring table.
	Each team must submit in the registration form the name of a Level 3 or higher judge, as well as a Technical Controller certified by Canada Artistic Swimming.

Competition Pool: 25m (8 lanes) 2 to 5m deep
Warmup Pool: 25m (8 lanes), 1.35m to 5m deep
All coach cards must be uploaded to Dropbox using your club's Dropbox folder before <u>Thursday, July 11 at 12 pm EST.</u>
All these coach cards will be imported into the scoring system and considered final, except in the 3 cases below:
1. Medical Issue
Clubs /provinces / federations who need to change a coach
card because of a medical issue that prevents them from
performing a routine as per submitted coach card will be
allowed to change their coach card up to 2 hours before the
start of a session (event blocks will be considered one session). These changes will need to be approved by the event Chief Referee.
2. Changes between Prelims and Final
n the event of prelims and finals at SYNC, clubs / provinces /
federations will be allowed to change their coach cards
between prelims and finals. The coach card has to be submitted no later than 20:00 the night before an event.
3. Last resort desperation move
Clubs / provinces / federations who want to change coach cards
for reasons other than the 2 above will be allowed to do so no
ater than 20:00 the night before an event but will need to pay a
\$100 fine to do so.
New coach cards will always need to be submitted by email to
Eve Turgeon in any of these instances. Confirmation of
submission will be provided by email reply.
11-12 athletes will compete two (2) figures at this event. These figures will be comprised of one (1) compulsory figure, and one (1) optional group figure drawn at random.

	Adapted athletes will compete two (2) figures at this event, comprised of one group drawn at random. One group will be selected for all Adapted levels.
	Draw for figures will take place on July 11 th , 2024.
	 Youth athlete will compete two (2) figures at this event. 1. Draw for Group A, B or C will take place on July 11th, 2024. 2. Draw for Group # will take place on July 15th, 2024. *All athletes will compete the same 2 figures **Draw results will be on Sportity

Submit the total payment to NAQ using the methods below no later than 10 days following registration (June 23, 2024). 4. Each PTSO will be responsible to confirm the registration in good standing of their members attending the event.

	Each athlete will be charged a competition fee of \$105 per day. Each coach or chaperone will be charged a competition fee of \$105 per day from Tuesday July 16 th to Saturday July 20th.
Competition Fees	 This competition daily fee includes: Bus transportation to and from the pool in the morning and in the evening Breakfast (served at the hotel) and dinner (served at the
	pool). Late entries or corrections to incomplete entries will be accepted beyond two weeks prior to the event start date, but
Late Entries	will be subject to the following fines: 2 weeks (14 days) prior to first event of the competition: \$50.00 per correction (to a maximum of \$500.00 per Club) Fines apply per figure event and/or per routine per event.
	Within 24 hours of the first event of the competition: \$100.00 per correction (to a maximum of \$500.00 per Club) Fines apply per figure event and/or per routine per event. <i>NAQ has the authority to refuse such a late entry if the number</i>
	creates an issue on the competition schedule.
	Solos, duets and mixed duets are limited to 2 entries for each age group by PTSO (Provincial federation) or club.
Entries Capacity	If after registration closes, the maximum capacity has not been reached in those events, provinces/federations/clubs may be invited to add additional entries.
	For any events that are part of the CAS 2024 Selection Process (if process there is), provinces must indicate which entry they are putting forward for selection at time of registration.
	The maximum capacity for Adapted Ability events is 20 entries. If that capacity is exceeded, provinces/federations/clubs may be asked to limit their entries.
	Entry payments must be received by Natation Artistique Québec no later than 10 days following the registration deadline (June 23, 2024)
